

2012 RSVP encana Golf Classic 10th Anniversary Rules Sheet

**Tuesday, May 8, 2012
Bridlewood Golf Club**

- USGA Rules govern play except as modified by local rules
- All Ties will be determined by USGA playoff rules (See Note)
- Fourteen Club Rule IS in Effect
- Play is Available for Amateurs Only

There will be two types of Groups, a Ladies group of foursomes and a Mixed (Men and Ladies) Group of foursomes. The Ladies foursome must consist of all Ladies. The Mixed flight may be any combination of Men and Lady players. There will be one flight in the Ladies Group) and two flights in the Mixed Group.

Ladies Group: 4 Person Scramble - One Flight

- All players will hit a tee shot select the best shot and all play from that common place. Repeat this procedure for all shots until the ball has been holed. *Threesomes*, alternate hitting the fourth shot with no individual hitting two consecutive shots.
- Gross Score – The team gross score for 18 holes will NOT be adjusted.
- Winning Teams – Teams will be listed in order of gross score that determines the three winners:
 - Low Gross winner is the Team with the low gross score
 - First Place winner is the Team with the second low gross score
 - Second Place winner is the Team with the third low gross score
- Ladies will play from the **RED** tees.
- At the completion of play please turn your signed and completed scorecard into the banquet room for banquet and awards presentation.
- The winner of the playoff, if required, between Low Gross and First Place will be the Overall Low Gross Winner. The loser of the playoff will be the Flight 1 Winner.
- The winner of the playoff, if required, between First Place and Second Place will be the First Place winner.

- Pace of Play Policy: If your group falls behind you will be issued 1 warning, if the problem continues you will be forced to move back into position. Please keep up with the group in front of you.

Mixed Group: 4 Person Scramble - Two Flights

- All players will hit a tee shot select the best shot and all play from that common place. Repeat this procedure for all shots until the ball has been holed. *Threesomes*, alternate hitting the fourth shot with no individual hitting two consecutive shots.
- Gross Score – The team gross score for 18 holes will NOT be adjusted.
- Flights – Teams will be listed in order of gross score then divided into the Low Gross Winner plus two flights:
 - Low Gross winner is the Team with the low gross score
 - Flight 1 consists of Teams in the top one half
 - Flight 2 consists of Teams in the bottom one half
- Places – Overall Gross Winner and 1st and 2nd Place will be awarded for 2 flights based on gross score (you can only win one place).
- Men will be playing from the **WHITE** tees and Ladies will play from the **RED** tees.
- At the completion of play please turn your signed and completed scorecard into the banquet room for banquet and awards presentation.
- The winner of the playoff, if required, between Low Gross and Flight 1 will be the Overall Gross Winner. The loser of the playoff will be the Flight 1 Winner.
- The winner of the playoff, if required, between Flight 1 and Flight 2 will be the winner of Flight 2.
- Pace of Play Policy: If your group falls behind you will be issued 1 warning, if the problem continues you will be forced to move back into position. Please keep up with the group in front of you.

Hole-in-One – Huffines Subaru and KIA

Hole-in-One - Metro Golf Car
Closest to the Pin AND Birdie the Hole

No Contest or Hole-in-One Hole may be won using a mulligan shot.

***Note:** The winner will be determined on the basis of the best score for the last nine holes. If the tying teams have the same score for the last nine holes, determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, the last three holes and finally the 18th hole. If a multiple tee start is used, the “last nine holes, last six holes, etc.” is considered to be holes 10 – 18, 13 – 18, etc. If the above procedure still results in a tie, then we would compare scores starting with the highest handicap hole, etc.*
